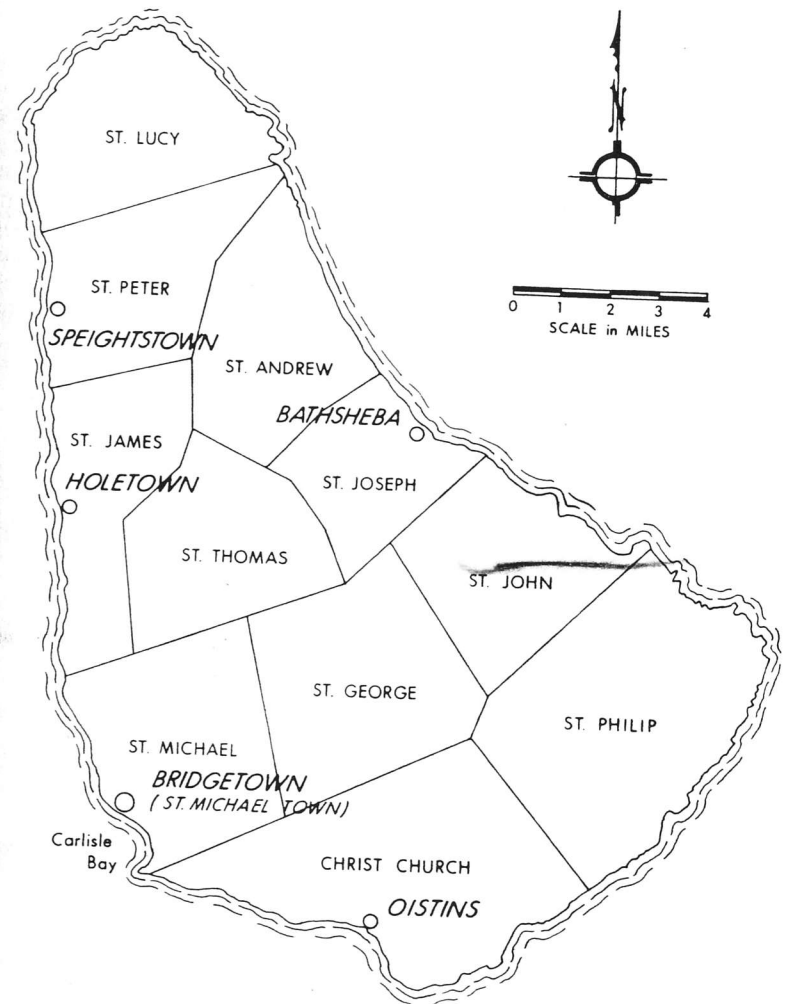

23 July 1705, RB4/18, p. 96

To be interred at the east end of St Michaels church yard in the grave where my uncle Jacob Brandt lies; my loving (bro) Charles Brandt; sis Margaret Mauzey; sis Mary Latemore; couzen Rebecah Dunckly; God son Bazill Dunckly; Madam Francis Collins widow and her sis Margaret Tyrwhitt widow; Charles Tyrwhitt and Francis Tyrwhitt* his wf; God son Richard Farrell, to buy him carpenter tools when his indenture expires; Elizabeth Beachfeild and her sis Ann Tyrwhitt spinster; ___ Jordan wf of John Jordan, her dau Elizabeth Mills; Mary Morgan spinster the dau late of Ann Morgan since married - 4 years schooling to be put out by her mo after my decease; friend Isaiah Davies; bro Randolph Brandt - Xtr, but as he lives in Mary Land remote from home I desire friends Capt. John Barry, John Jordan, and Bazell Dunckley Sr - Xtrs during my bro's absence; my negro woman Mallapa and her child Atseber (or Atfeber) ___ ale live with John Jourdan and his wf ___ ill my bro shall send for them. signed Brandt

St Philips Parish, 19 Aug 1709, RB6/5, p. 266

My dau Avis Brathwaite at 14; nephew Thomas Downes at 21; my bro John Williams chn Elizabeth Williams* and Richard Williams*; my bro Elding's dau Mary Elding*; sis Ann Downes; my bro Nathanile Brathwaite and his son; son John Brathwaite at 21 - Xtr; my wf Elizabeth Brathwaite, my bro Robert Brathwaite and William King, and friends John Rous and Capt. Allen Culpeper - Overseers; my said wf, bros Robert Brathwaite and William Elding, friends Col. John Rous and Allyne Culpeper - Gdns. signed John Brathwaite

Wit: John Sandford, Reg: Webb, Francis Culpeper

Proved 18 Dec 1709 at the Chapell Plantation.

BRERETON, Henry

Christ Church Parish, 10 Dec 1719, RB6/6, p. 39

Dau Mary Brereton - a cedar table which was her mo's; son Henry Brereton at 21 - land in St Philips Parish butting Ralph Weeks Esq, James Collgreen, Christopher Lacey, and Margaret Lacy, also slaves formerly his mo's; my wf Jane Brereton and my son Edward Brereton - Xtrs and Gdns of son Henry; dau Elizabeth Strutton. signed Henry Brereton

Wit: Charles Rawlins, Thos: Griffith

Proved 4 Feb 1719

BRESS, John, planter, being sick and weak in body.

St Thomas Parish, 7 Apr 1719, RB6/6, p. 238

My eldest dau Rebekah McKeanan; son John Bress and youngest dau Elizabeth Bress - Xtrs. signed John Bress

Wit: William Williams, William Odell

Proved 8 May 1721

BRIDGES, John, mariner, being sick in body.

22 Mar 1721, RB6/6, p. 418

Friend Mary Burke of the parish of St Michaels aforesaid the wf of Edmund Barke (Burke) late of Bdos Gent. - Xtrx and legatee. signed John Bridges

Wit: Humphrey Cockram, Waltr: Gikien, Isaac LeGay

Proved 19 Apr 1722

BRIDLE, James, planter

St Philips Parish, 11 Oct 1702, RB6/37, p. 548

Sis Mary Bridle living at Worthes in the parish of Castock, Co. Dorset, England; sis Joan Bridle now wf of James Barnet living in the same Co.; wf Jane Bridle - Xtrx. signed James (x) Bridle

Wit: Joseph Gibbs, More Gold, Richd: Morris, Jonathan Clayton

Proved 1 Dec 1702

BRIEN, Dennis

St Andrews Parish, 7 Dec 1720, RB6/6, p. 141

Sons John Bryen and Daniell Brien and dau Elizabeth Brien all at full age; friend Humphrey Murraine (also spelled Murrean) - Xtr. signed Denis (x) Brien

Wit: Dennis Murrain, Jas: Comer

Proved 15 Dec 1720

BRIGGS, Cornelius of Bdos, planter, being very sick.

St Philips Parish, 11 Jan 1724, RB6/22, p. 543

My dau Abigail Batson; (several blanks) sons Michael Briggs and Samuel Briggs - each 1/2 of the land that was my gr fa Michael Start's; my son Robert Briggs - land that was Robert Haughton's decd; my son William - my dwelling house and land; sons Michael and William Briggs - Xtrs and to maintain sons Samuel and Robert to age 21. signed Cornelius (x) Briggs
