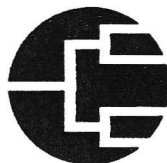

He also held services Sunday and Monday nights. Mr Breaker is well known throughout South Florida as a very able minister of the Baptist denomination. In a letter from Samuel Graham Frierson to his wife, Fernandina, Nov 04 1861  
 A very serious accident happened in our camp on yesterday. Manly Braker and George Atkins was playing and Manly had a piece of wood (?) in his hand and said to George he would shoot him and George jumped in the tent and caught up a gun and shot Manly through the heart. He never said anything except Oh, Lordy was all he said. I left camp about two hours before the accident. I never was so sorry for anything in my life. I had just left them in fine spirits and then see Manly a corpse. We will start the corpse home tomorrow. Mr Braker was down here a few days ago. He left last week. I expect it will almost kill him

#### A Veteran Mustered Out

One of the oldest Baptist preachers of America, either in age or in years of service, passed away when the Rev James Henry Breaker died. He was 77 years old last April. For fifty five years he preached the gospel and filled pulpits in the North, South, East and West. His death came at 12:30 a m, Sunday. It was caused by heart failure.

For years and years that Mr Breaker preached the word it was in the thinly settled portions of the South, when he rode his circuit on horseback. During the past twenty-two years he had charges in various portions of St Louis, MO, where the simplicity of his life and the earnestness of his work endeared him to many people outside of his own denomination. He was married three times and leaves five living children, all grown and married, and many grandchildren. His last wife died four years ago when he was filling the Baptist pastorate in Carondelet. (MO) Then Mr Breaker gave up active work and since then had no regular charge. For a man of his age he was remarkably strong and well preserved, and enjoyed robust health until a few weeks ago. During the last year he made two long railway journeys to Tennessee, where one of his sons lives. Two weeks ago the old gentleman was stricken with heart disease. At his advanced age the physician saw the end. His absent children were summoned by telegraph. They were with him when the end came, as quietly and as peacefully as had been his life, early Sunday morning at the home of his son-in-law, W H Grate, 4140 Louisana ave. The old minister was born in Edgefield, S C, Aapril 28, 1820. when but a child he removed with his parents to the island of Key West, off the coast of Southern Florida, and there he was reared. He went to New England when a youth, and finished his education there. The young man studied medicine in Connecticut, and was licensed to preach in that state at the age of 22 years. For a few years the young minister preached in New England and then went South, settling first in his native state. He answered various calls, and filled several pulpits in that state and frequently had to ride from twenty five to fifty miles on horseback to fill a Sunday's appointment to preach. Then the Rev Mr Breaker went to Florida, where he remained until he removed to St Louis, in 1872. His first pastorate in the county was at Gray Summit, where for years he was the hard-working and beloved pastor of the Brush Creek Baptist Church. From that charge he went to the Carondelet Baptist church, then to Concordia Baptist church and then back again to Carondelet. Later he preached at times in various portions of the county, but the Carondelet was his last regular church.— St Louis (MO) Post Dispatch

Robert:

Thanks for the great synopsis of your trip and all the info. We are going to spend two night's in Camden and I will make every effort to get copies of the documents you want at the Camden Archives.

The Abby D.(Niles) Breaker story is an interesting connection for us. She was the wife of JH[James Henry] Breaker who I believe (?) was JMC's brother and also a Baptist Preacher. He may have been a traveling preacher as he appears all over the south preaching, performing marriages and getting married once or twice himself after Abby's passing. Interestingly he is not listed in the 1850 Census [Groton] CT where Abby's mother Martha Niles is listed as head of household with her four married daughters (including Abby, Lucy and their children) and their children. I may be mistaken, but I seem to remember she died in CT (and is buried there), but her obit was in both SC and Florida (where I assume her husband was preaching). The interesting connection here is that John William Henry (JH & JMC's first cousin) married Abby D. Niles sister Lucy Ann Niles. John William Henry & Lucy are our line and we have them fully documented down to the present generation. If you get to the point where you want the info on their line let me know and I'll put it together for you. We're actually working on a booklet on Queenie's grandparent's one of whom was John William Henry's grandson William Dudley Breaker. I'll let you know when it's completed, but if want any info before then let me know. There is another interesting point of difference in the branching of our two lines. Your Breakers took to the church, mine to the sea (excepting Charles Middleton, who I guess you've come across). Both John William Henry and his son Lewis (Capt. Louie) were sea captains and I have some little information about their adventures. They were both at Key West Florida at one time. There are multiple connections amongst the Breakers, SC, Key West & Mystic CT both because of the seafaring connections and the Baptist Church. I seem to remember Lewis and Martha sending one of their sons back from Key West to SC to study for the church because he was becoming too interested in the sea, possibly the influence of cousin John William Henry! One other connection is that John William Henry was lost @ sea with his crew of seven in I believe (I'm at work and writing from memory) 1840. Abby and JH named a son after John William Henry a few years after his demise.

Oh yes we know about the Chapel of Ease in Goose Creek. I'll let Queenie tell you the whole story (and I am sending her a copy of this letter to encourage her to do so) of her visit there with her sister and brother & sister in law. It was some piece of detective work, but they tramped through some woods and found it in a sorry state of disrepair. I will ask you one thing as this question comes up every time that graveyard is mentioned, which is this:

Susan Breaker is buried next to a William Lewis and Queenie is convinced he must fit into the family someplace. Have you come across any Lewis'? Someone has photos of the graveyard which I will try to find and get copies of for you.

Those early Breaker men apparently didn't care much for being widowers and Charles Middleton had at least one other wife. I forget her given name but her surname was Screven.

There is only one male 'Breaker' in our line still living and I am still trying to track him down. There are also three 'Breaker' girls [my second cousins] of my generation that I am also searching for. They may have some Breaker family info. At least I hope so. The earliest Breaker photo I have is of Queenie's grandfather 'Pop' Breaker which I'll send you under separate cover to see if he shares any physical similarities with those in your Branch. I'll keep in touch. Best Regards. Corny

PS One other thing occurred to me while I was searching for where I stuck PoP's photo. You notice that John Henry William Breaker named his son Lewis, assumedly after your Lewis. I notice the that once the Breaker's find a name they like they stick with it (not that I can talk as I'm a IV). At any rate Queenie's grandfather had three children: Helen (Queenie's mother); William Dudley Jr. and Lewis Coates. This Lewis also ran a newspaper out on Long Island's North Fork where Queenie and two of her three siblings now live. She may have more details of Uncle 'Louie'. I only remember him from when I was a young boy.

appointed Samuel C. CRAFT, editor. The paper followed the democratic party line. John Edward SPENCER, died of dysentery, 30 June 1866, and the publication was continued by Thomas K. SPENCER.

The Republicans bought controlling interest of the paper in 1872 and the editor, Samuel C. CRAFT, retired and the paper once again ceased to exist in 1877.

His son, Thomas K. SPENCER, began publishing the Sunland Tribune, with the first issue on on 2 March 1876, with Dr. John P. WALL, editor. Thomas K. was elected to the Board of Public Instruction, Hillsborough County, in 1870. He is listed in the 1886 Tampa City Directory, as the editor, Tampa Tribune, and SPENCER & SCALES, PUBLISHERS.

Others in the household were:

\* Eliza Jane SPENCER, born 3 November 1835 in Hamilton County, Florida, married Rev. James Henry BREAKER, 10 July 1853, in Hillsborough County Florida. He was an ordained Baptist Minister. She died 2 September 1854 in St. Louis, Missouri.

William James SPENCER, born 3 February 1839 in Columbia County, Florida, died 7 October 1862 in Frankford, Kentucky of typhoid fever, during the Civil War.

John Edward SPENCER, born 13 August 1841, Columbia County, Florida, died 30 June 1866. He enlisted in the 4th Florida Infantry, during the Civil War, but was discharged due to being underage, at 15 years of age. He later re-enlisted, was captured at Ft. Lafayette, New York, and was involved in a prisoner exchange and then re-enlisted in Capt. John T. LESLEY'S Company.

Caroline Elizabeth SPENCER, born 30 July 1843, married William B. HENDERSON, 8 February 1860, Rev. Leroy G. LESLEY, officiating. She died 14 December 1906.

Mary Eugenia SPENCER, born 15 November 1844, died 22 February 1931, and is buried in Oaklawn Cemetery. She married Henry Laurens MITCHELL, 11 April 1866.
