



William Hornby and his wife Hannah Oldum, married 1752, came from Queen's County, Ireland to Charleston, South Carolina, prior to 1776 - some years prior are indicated. Established himself as a merchant in the city. His children, Hannah, Eleanor,

William, Phillip, and Thomas, were all born in Ireland, but the birth order is not known.

The family were communicants of St. Michael's Church, Charleston, South Carolina. Records of the church were unfortunately destroyed by Gen. Sherman, during the War Between the States. Children Hannah, Eleanor and William Hornby, Jr. died unmarried.

Philip married first in 1783 Henrietta Kelsall Goldsmith, a widow, in Georgia. She died in 1786.
